DJS Start of Year Information

SEPTEMBER START/FINISH TIMES:

- Gates open at 8:40am for all children with a member of staff outside supervising; please use the entrance gate that is most convenient for you; children to wait on the either playground for the whistle to blow at 8:50am; 1st whistle children to stand still quietly 2nd whistle Mrs Read/Ms Cope to call one year group at a time to make their way to their classroom external classroom fire doors will still be used; for parents dropping children off at the Infants please note that registration is by 9:00am. The school gates will be locked at 9:05am. Anyone arriving after this time should enter via the school office.
- On the first day of term all teachers will be on the playground to meet their class and direct them to their classroom.
- The school day will finish at **3:10pm** for all classes. Parents of children in Year 3 & Year 4 wishing to meet their child after school may do so on Vawdrey Road playground waiting around the perimeter and avoiding classroom entrances.
- Any parents/carers wishing to speak to a member of staff should ideally make an appointment. Settling the children first thing has to be our priority.

SCHOOL OFFICE: If you need to visit the school office please continue to do so one at a time, adhering to social distancing. The wearing of face masks is encouraged and appreciated.

PE KITS: From September all children should wear their PE kits to school on the days that they have PE. This greatly saves time, maximising lesson time for the children. All children should wear a PE kit that matches the school colours as it is part of the school uniform. Please see below which days each class will be having PE:

4B - Monday, Wednesday; 4P - Monday, Tuesday; 4L - Monday, Tuesday;

5H - Monday, Thursday; 5L - Monday, Thursday; 5S - Monday, Thursday

6W - Tuesday, Wednesday; 6G - Tuesday, Wednesday; 6F - Tuesday, Thursday


