## **DJS Information Update**

**PASTORAL LEAD:** In the new school year Mrs Clarke, who joined the DJS team this term, will be available two mornings a week to provide pastoral support for our families. We are all very excited by her new role. Not only will Mrs Clarke be available to listen and help parents/carers experiencing difficulties with their child's behaviour or anxieties, she be delivering practical training workshops linked to the 'Working with Worries' project being rolled out across schools.
